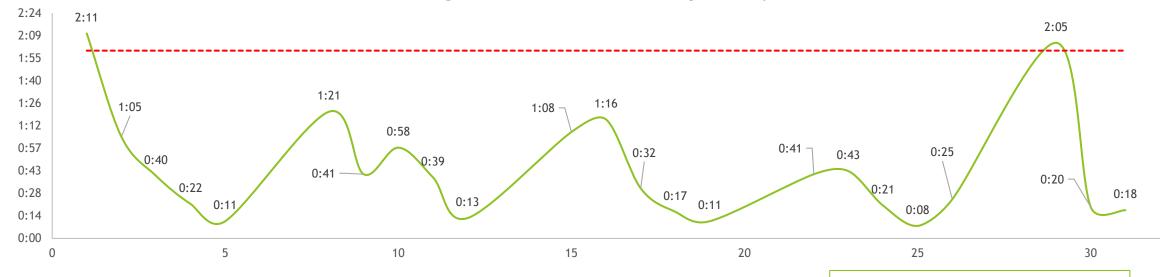


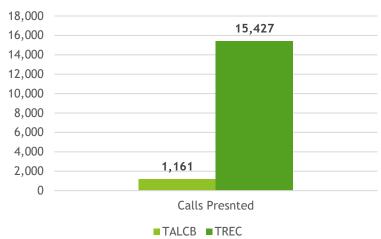

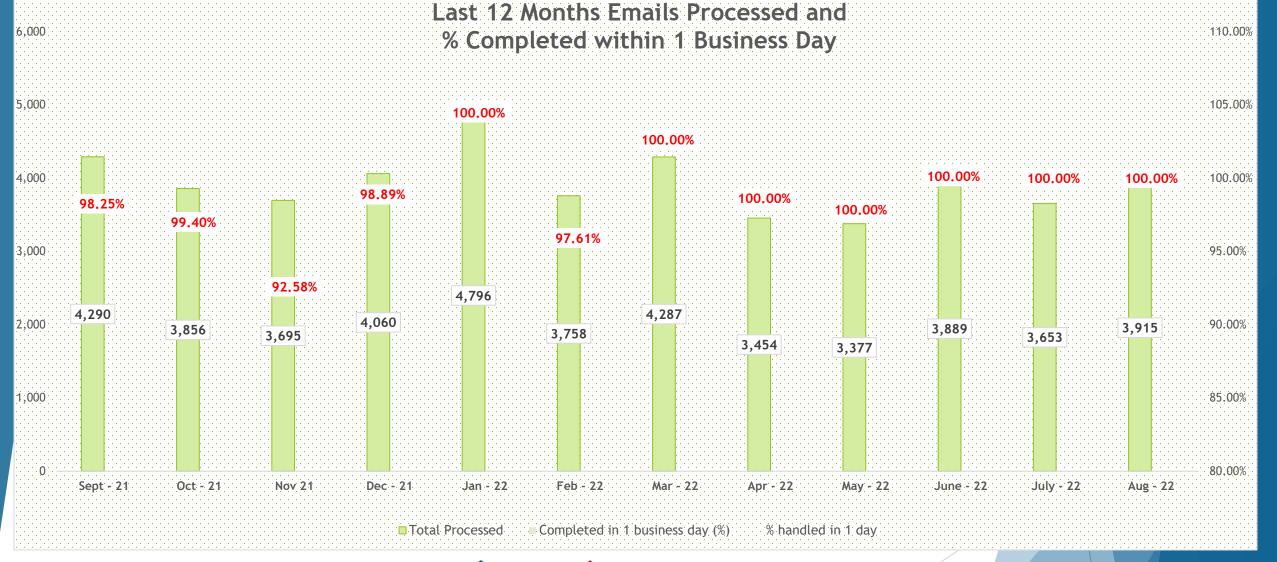

Last 12 Months Calls Presented vs. Hold Time

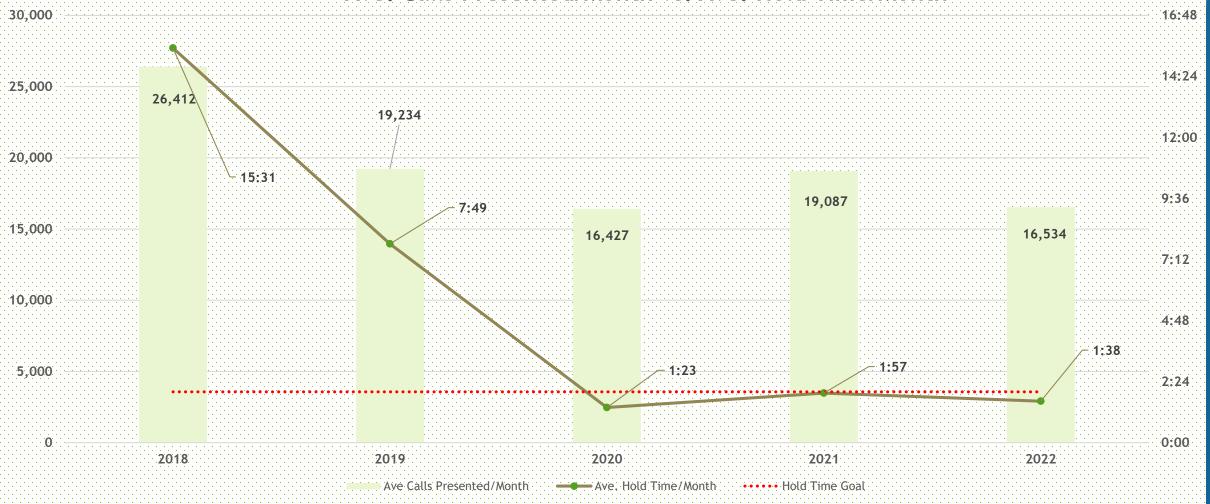








Fiscal Year Comparison Ave. Calls Presented/Month vs. Ave. Hold Time/Month

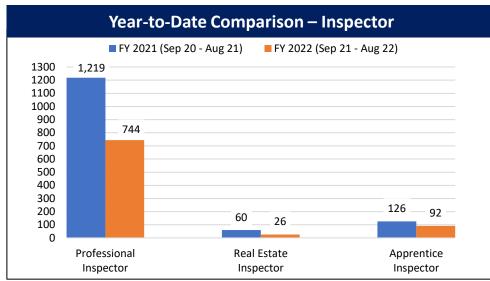
All TREC Applications Approved Year-Over-Year Comparison

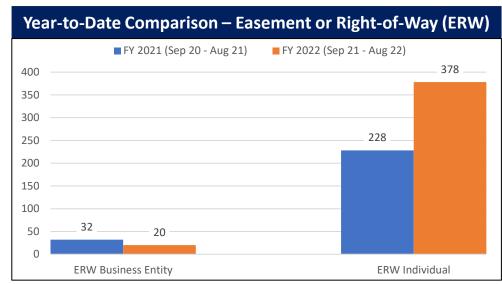

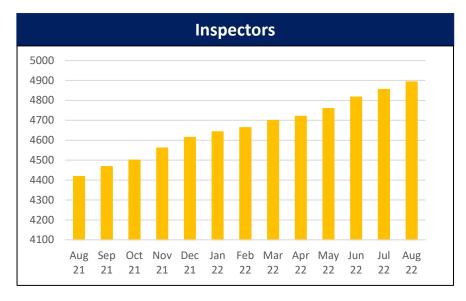


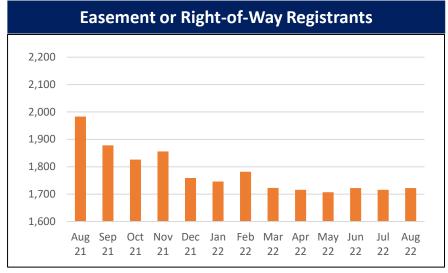
License Holder Counts

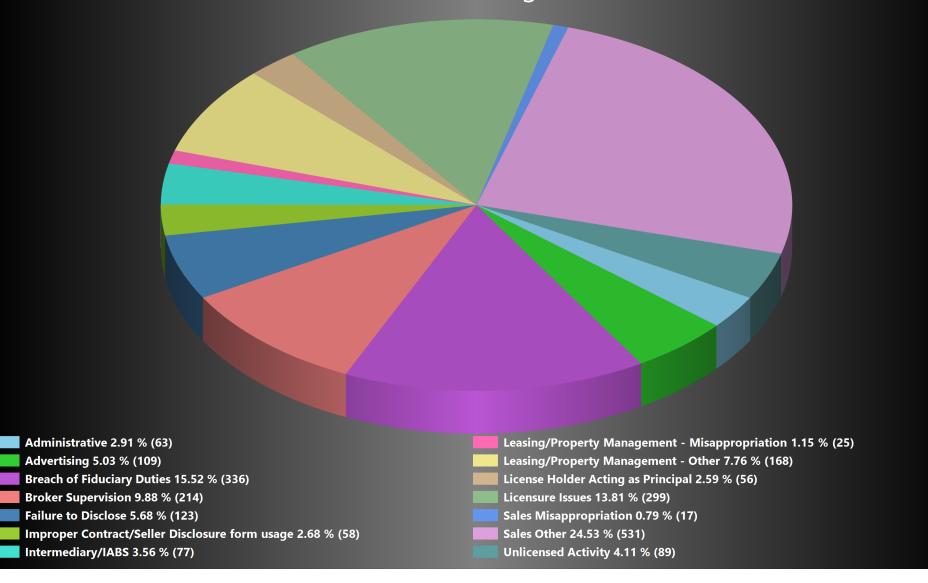
